What is it?



- Legal underpinning for student mobility for studies (including short term blended mobility) and staff mobility for teaching
- Bilaterally negotiated between partners
- Consists out of:
 - General information about each of the institutions that can be updated at any time without the need for approval by the counterpart;
 - Terms of the agreement that to be negotiated and approved by both HEIs.





What it does cater for
